English/Reading:

In **reading** we will be reading "Knots in My Yo-Yo" and complete various activities related to author's purpose, infer, text connections, & analyze.

In **English** we will focus on kinds of sentences throughout the week. We will continue discussing the writing process and working with various components of that.

Math/A.S:

This week in **Math** we will begin Investigation 2 in our Bits and Pieces I book. This includes finding equivalent fractions, comparing fractions to benchmarks, finding fractions between fractions, improper fractions, and mixed numbers. We will quiz over this information the following week

We will complete Unit 5 in Spelling during A.S. Spelling HW will be due on Wednesday and the test will be on Friday. We will also continue to review basic math concepts

Science/Geo.

In **Social Studies**, we will continue with atlas work on Monday and Tuesday and work with globes on Thursday and Friday. On Wednesday we will look at current events and line graphs in our *Scholastic News*. We will work with Study Island on *Graphs, Timelines, Charts and Diagrams* this week. We will have a summative test on Friday. Using study island at home is great practice and preparation for the test.

In **Science**, students will complete a Study Island module on *Collecting and Interpreting Data* on Monday. Please feel free to use Study Island at home to practice and review new concepts. We will have a scientific method review on Tuesday and test on Wednesday. Our common assessment will be on Thursday. We will watch a video on Friday introducing our next unit of study, *Life Science*.
